THE PASTOR'S CORNER:

OPEN INVITATION

In the Kingdom of Heaven, God, the Father, is the King who prepared a special wedding banquet for His Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and the King sent a very special invitation for His chosen guests. Actually, the King sent the invitation twice, to make sure that His special guests will come to the wedding banquet, but unfortunately, no one attended the banquet. So the King opened the banquet for everyone, the good and the bad that they found in the streets. However, one of the guests who attended the banquet was not properly dressed, and when the King asked for an explanation, the guest did not say a thing and did not care about what the King was saying.

It is saddening to know that there are people, like the chosen guests, who do not respond to God's invitation at all; and there are people, like the guest who was not properly dressed, who do not care at all about God's goodness to them. If we will not respond to God's invitation, God will surely punish us, like what the King did to those chosen guests who ignored the invitation to the banquet. This is also the reason why the guest who was not properly dressed in the wedding banquet was punished. The guest was a beneficiary of the King's goodness in the wedding banquet, but would not participate at all in the required attire in the banquet, and did not say anything at all to the King or did not care at all about the King's presence.

God cares about all of us, good and bad alike. We each received an invitation from God so, if we want to belong to His Kingdom in Heaven, we need to respond to His call and get involve or participate in His work in the church and in the world. We are, certainly, not going to enter heaven if we do not care, or do nothing for our God and for our neighbor.

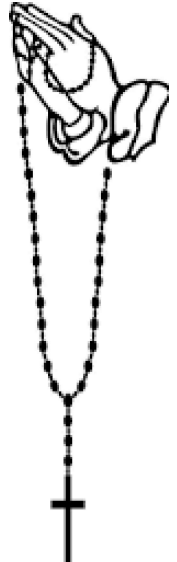
