RESURRECTION


For three days, the disciples went into hiding for fear that Jews will come after them now that the Master, our Lord Jesus Christ, was dead. But after they heard the news of the resurrection from the women and the two disciples who were on the road to Emmaus, the apostles too resurrected from the state of being dead. It was a new day, a new life and a new hope for this group of disciples. Even though the disciples still did not understand the meaning of the words in the scriptures that Jesus will have to rise from the dead after three days, they now believe in the resurrection of the dead and have seen the glory of the Risen Lord.

It is very important that the disciples believe in the resurrection of life because this is the very reason that God became man like us. After our first parents, Adam and Eve were sent out of Paradise, the plan of God was to bring us all back to Him through the resurrection of His Only Begotten Son, Jesus. Now that the disciples themselves have resurrected from that state of dying and witnessed the resurrection, they must go out and proclaim to all the people and nations that Jesus has risen from the dead and that through His grace we will also be raised from the dead.

As followers and disciples of the Lord, there will be days like we want to go on a hiding or we get afraid to become a missionary disciple of Jesus. But now that we have undergone the process of how to be a mature disciple and learned the dimensions of discipleship, and then the Easter Season tells us about the first disciples have testified for us the resurrection of our Lord, this is now the time for us to come out and proclaim the Good News of our salvation. However, as we do our missionary apostolate as disciples of the Lord, we will still encounter persecutions and criticisms but we do not have to live in fear of them anymore because even death has no power against the grace of the resurrection of the Risen Lord that was given to us as His disciples.
