THE PASTOR'S CORNER: "....the truth of life in HIM."

EUCHARISTIC SACRIFICE

Every time we celebrate the Holy Eucharist, we remember the holy sacrifice made by our Lord Jesus Christ on the cross where He gave His Body and Blood so that all of us will live. Jesus sacrificed His life, so that His Body to become the true food and His Blood the true drink that will give us eternal life in heaven.

"Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and I will raise him on the last day."

One of the old symbols used by the church on the Eucharistic sacrifice is the pelican. The mother pelican, when she has caught no fish to feed her young or during the days of famine, strikes her breast with the beak to feed her baby pelicans with her own flesh and blood. Another version of this symbolism says that the mother pelican feeds her dying baby pelicans with her flesh and blood to revive them from death, but in turn the mother pelican loses her own

The pelican symbolizes our Lord Jesus Christ, who sacrificed His own Body and Blood so that all of us will live and have eternal life. On this feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, let us worthily receive the Holy Eucharist so that all of us will gain eternal life in heaven. Let us pray to our Lord Jesus Christ, that we may all have the grace and the strength to be able to make our own small or big sacrifices in life.

As we celebrate also, Fathers' Day, let us pray for all fathers, grandfathers, great grandfathers, great great grandfathers, that all their works and sacrifices for their family and their children will be blessed by God, our Father in heaven.


