THE PASTOR'S CORNER: "....the truth of life in HIM."

DISCIPLES' SERVICE

Why do the disciples need to leave their father and mother? Why do the disciples have to take up the cross? Why do the disciples have to leave their homes and possessions? Why did the Master, our Lord Jesus Christ, ask the disciples to lose or offer their lives?

A worthy disciple of Jesus is the one who is always ready and available to serve the people of God. There are, of course, other ways to serve the people, but service as a disciple of the Lord means total self-giving and sacrifice. If a disciple serves without sacrifice, he is not really serving at all as a disciple of our Lord Jesus Christ, who served and gave His all and His life to the people given to Him by God, the Father.

The Books of the Old Testament contain stories of prophets who sacrificed everything to serve God. The Books of the New Testament tell us many stories of the disciples who left everything, followed our Lord Jesus, and went on a mission to teach and baptize all the nations. The Gospel on this 13th Sunday is calling on us to become worthy and matured missionary disciples of Jesus by giving ourselves to the Lord and making necessary sacrifices for the Gospel. The Strategic Plan of our Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux is to make all of us matured missionary disciples of the Lord. Let us therefore pray to the master to grant us the grace and the strength to make sacrifices and become worthy and matured missionary disciples.

If for some good reasons that we cannot do the missions, the Gospel is asking us, as matured disciples of Jesus, we can still serve in many other ways, like welcoming the disciples of Jesus into your homes or giving a cup of cold water to the little disciples of the Lord. Not that we are after a reward, but a disciple who serves the Lord or a disciple who welcomes a disciple of the Lord, according to the Gospel, will surely receive a reward from the Master, our Lord Jesus Christ.

ADORATION ON FRIDAYS


Adoration is on Fridays from 3:00PM - 7:00PM in the Chapel.
