I would like to thank all of you my dear parishioners of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary and friends for your prayers and gifts as I celebrated my birthday last Thursday, July 6. I would like thank all of you, especially, for the food in potluck dinner. May our Lord Jesus continue to bless us all!

I would like us to reflect and honor the life of St. Maria Goretti, my patron saint and whose feast day was celebrated by the whole church last July 6. Maria was twelve years old when Alessandro attacked her and died from the 14 stabbed wounds. At the hospital before Maria died, she prayed for her mother, her family, her surgeon and she forgave her attacker, Alessandro that he will repent and be with her in heaven.

The Gospel tells how God reveals His love and wisdom to little ones like St. Maria Goretti, a true and matured little disciple of our Lord Jesus Christ. Because of Maria's forgiveness, Alessandro after 27 years in prison, he repented and became a lay brother of the Order of Friars Minor Capuchin until his death. The miracle of the little disciple is the miracle of love and forgiveness.

Our Lord Jesus Christ is inviting us, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened and I will give you rest . . . for I am meek and humble of heart." Through the inspiration of St. Maria Goretti, may our hearts be loving and forgiving, meek and humble. Let us pray for the grace of repentance, so that all of us may be worthy of the everlasting life in heaven.
