FEEDING OF THE POOR

Our Lenten Mission Appeal 2016 will be for the Diocese of Lucena in the Philippines. The bishop of the diocese, Most Rev. Emilio Z. Marguez D.D., has been giving rice and feeding the poor people of the diocese every Monday. On April 18, 2016, Our Church of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary will be the sponsor in the feeding of the one thousand poor people, and the giving of five kilos of rice to each family. There will be a Mass and Catechism to be presided by the bishop before the distribution of food and rice. I will be travelling to the Philippines in the month of April to represent Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary Church in this Lenten Mission Appeal.

In this Year of Mercy, our God, the Father, in heaven who is so rich in mercy, is reaching out to our poor brothers and sisters through our help. Our Lord Jesus Christ, the face of the Father's mercy, came to the world and fed thousands of people who are hungry. He showed and taught us the corporal works of mercy, especially the feeding of the poor and the hungry. We have a chance today to continue the work of the Lord, and help bring the Father's mercy to others through our Lenten Mission Appeal.

Let us offer our prayers and share our blessings to the poor people in the Diocese of Lucena in the Philippines, and let us pray for God's blessings for our church and our families through this Lenten Mission Appeal.

Our Lenten Reflection on the Seven Last Words of our Lord Jesus Christ on the cross will be every Friday at 3:30 p.m. in this Lenten Season. On Good Friday. March 25, the reflection on the seventh word will be at 2:00 p.m.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT

All Fridays in Lent are mandatory days of abstaining from meat. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are mandatory days of <u>fasting</u> and <u>abstaining</u> from meat. All Catholics who have reached the age of 14 are required by Church law to observe mandatory days of abstaining from meat. All Catholics who have reached the age of 18 are required by Church law to observe mandatory days of fasting, and are limited to one full meal without meat. This requirement ceases for an individual upon his/her 59th birthday (canon 1252).
