

THE PASTOR'S CORNER:

THE GREAT LIGHT

Jesus was born in Bethlehem, went to live in Egypt then came back to Israel to live in the town of Nazareth. But as He began His public ministry, Jesus made Capernaum by the Sea of Galilee, his hometown. Our Lord Jesus Christ wanted to start His ministry from a place, which according to the Prophet Isaiah, is the land of the gentiles or sinners. So, the people of Capernaum and Galilee who were living in darkness had finally seen the Great Light, our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ who proclaimed and said, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

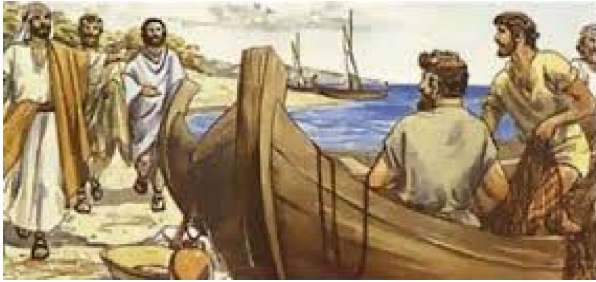
