THE PASTOR'S CORNER: "....the truth of life in HIM."

SHEPHERDING

As disciples of the Lord, one of our tasks is to shepherd the sheep and lead them to the Gate, who is Jesus Christ. Just like the Good Shepherd, a disciple walks ahead of the sheep and the disciple protects his sheep from the robbers. A disciple does not run when the sheep are in the face of danger, and will sacrifice even his or her life to save the sheep. When a sheep gets lost, the shepherd/disciple goes out to search for the lost sheep, and when the disciple found the sheep, that disciple will bring back the sheep to the sheepfold through the Gate.

The question, however, is who will be the shepherd of the shepherds or the disciples? What will happen if the shepherd or the disciple is the one who gets lost?

The term shepherding is therefore very important in the life of a mature missionary disciple. Shepherding does not pertain only between the relationship of the shepherd and the sheep, but shepherding happens also among or between shepherds. As a group of shepherds or disciples, they come together to pray to the Good Shepherd, who will surely help and lead them to the right direction as shepherds leading the sheep. After all, the sheep belongs to the Good Shepherd Himself, so much so that, He will not let one sheep or shepherd gets lost.

Let us pray for all the bishops, pastors and priests who shepherd the flock entrusted to them by the Good Shepherd, our Lord Jesus Christ. Let us pray also for the sheep that they will always listen and follow their shepherd so that they will not get lost, and hopefully both the shepherd and the sheep get to enter the Gate, our Lord Jesus Christ.
