THE PASTOR'S CORNER: "...the truth of life in HIM."

GRACE, MERCY AND BLESSINGS

FATHER – God, the Father, the First Person in the Most Holy Trinity, is the source of all the graces we receive. The most gracious Father gives us all the good things in this world. When the Father gives, He gives to everybody, both those who are deserving and not deserving to receive. One example of God's goodness and graciousness is that, He makes the sun shine for both good and evil men. As we are all sinful men before God, anything we receive is called Grace because we do not deserve these good things. We are nothing but unworthy recipients of the goodness of God, which is called Grace.

SON – The Only Begotten Son of God, our Lord Jesus Christ, is the Second Person in the Most Holy Trinity and He is the source of mercy and forgiveness. Because of our sins, what we all deserve are punishment and death, but our merciful and forgiving Lord spared us from punishment and death that we all deserve. Therefore, if we do not believe in the Holy Spirit and if we do not pray to the Holy Spirit, we will not be able to receive God's Grace and Mercy, and we will never be forgiven from our sins.

Every time we pray and make the sign of the cross, we profess our faith and trust to the Most Holy Trinity, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and at that very moment, we receive the Grace, Mercy, and Blessings of God.
