UNLIMITED GRACE

In the face of dangers and persecutions, our Lord Jesus Christ called His disciples to proclaim the Gospel from the housetops. Jesus said that the apostles should not be afraid of anything or anyone because His grace is more than enough and overflowing. God gives us His unlimited grace, more than what we need, for our limited life.

Jeremiah, in the first reading, heard whispers of terror against him but he did not stop from singing, praising and proclaiming God because he trusted that God will deliver the just from tests and persecutions. St. Paul, in the second reading, wrote to the Romans that even though sin entered the world because of Adam, Jesus entered the world to bring the overflowing grace of God to save all men and women from the terrors of sin and death.


