THE PASTOR'S CORNER: "....the truth of life in HIM."

BREATH OF GOD

In the story of creation, after God formed man out of clay, He breathed on the clay and man received life. After the resurrection, when Jesus recreated our mortal body, from a corruptible to a glorified body, He breathed on us once again and we received life, that is, the Holy Spirit.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Pentecost, the Gospel tells us again how Jesus breathed on the Apostles and how they received the Holy Spirit that gives life. Immediately, these apostles who were afraid of the Jews became fearless followers of our Risen Lord. The Apostles came out from hiding, spoke in different languages, and proclaimed the teachings of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Apostles became God's new creation as they were strengthened by the power of the Holy Spirit. The people in Jerusalem were amazed on what had happened to these Galileans, and they believed that this was the mighty act of God. Many were baptized and converted that day, and they became followers of our Lord Jesus Christ.

When we were baptized, we received the Holy Spirit, that is, we were born again in Spirit. When we received the Sacrament of Confirmation, we received once again the Holy Spirit, who strengthens us and makes us matured disciples of our Lord Jesus Christ. Let us pray to the Holy Spirit, not only on this Day of the Pentecost, but every day, so that the Holy Spirit may come and renew us daily. Let us hope that through the Holy Spirit, we may become matured missionary disciples of the Lord, ready to proclaim His teachings to all the people around us.

This weekend we are going to celebrate the 40th Anniversary of our Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux. Let us pray for all the faithful of every parish church in our diocese, so that we all become matured missionary disciples of our Lord Jesus Christ, through the grace of the Holy Spirit on this Day of the Pentecost.

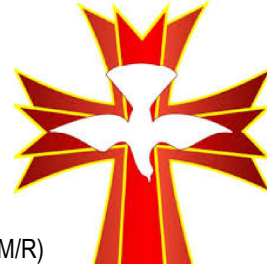
