

THE PASTOR'S CORNER:

“LITTLE FAITH”

The Transfiguration of our Lord Jesus Christ up in the mountain supposed to have strengthened the faith of Peter, but when the Lord tested the faith of Peter, he failed.

Jesus had to perform another miracle by walking on the water to strengthen the faith of other apostles who were not with Him when He transfigured up in the mountain.
