We gather today to celebrate the 69th anniversary of our church of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary. We celebrate also today the birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary, mother of our Lord Jesus Christ and our mother.

As a church under the patronage of the Virgin Mary, we gather as her children and with her Son, Jesus, in our midst, we pray for more disciples who will follow our Lord. For the last three years and the years before that, Holy Rosary Parish has been making mature missionary disciples.

Our Pastoral and Finance Councils and different committees of Liturgy, Family Fun Day, Building and Grounds Improvement, Service/H Team/ERG and Condolence Committee have been working, together with our Staff, in serving our church and our community. Our Implementation Team and Come Lord Jesus Groups are helping us in our Adult Formation. We have RCIA and Adult Confirmation. Lastly, we have our Youth Ministry, CCD program and the Come and Listen program forming and teaching our young and little disciples in church.

In the midst of all of these, we thank the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ and of God, our Father, for giving us all these blessings and the many disciples in our parish, who have been so generous and kind in supporting the church. Looking forward to our grand celebration of 70 years next year, we pray to the Holy Spirit and to Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary, that there will be many more disciples, who will come to support and to serve in our church.
