

THE PASTOR'S CORNER:

LITTLE CROSS OF DISCIPLESHIP

On September 8, 2018, our church of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary will be celebrating its 70th Anniversary. On that day, Saturday, at the 4:00 p.m. Vigil Mass, our Beloved Bishop Shelton Fabre will preside in the Eucharistic Celebration and in the blessing of our renovated altar and church.

In preparation for our anniversary celebration, I would like to ask from you, my dear parishioners, a little sacrifice, a little cross to carry. Starting September 9, 2017, on the day of the solemn opening celebration of our 70th year anniversary, I would like to ask you to donate .50 cents a day, for the funds that we will use for the Phase II and III of the renovation of our church, which will start on September 11, 2017. Our goal for next year is to have \$70,000 for our 70 years, and to have the church ready for the blessing. This will be achieved through the grace of God and by donating .50 cents a day or \$182.50 for the whole year. We will have the donation box at the altar in our church throughout the year. Let us pray and hope that we will be able to achieve our goal for our 70 years celebration.

Our Lord Jesus Christ said to us in the Gospel that if we wish to follow Him and become His disciple, we would have to carry our cross daily. The cross comes in different sizes and weights but the Lord will not give us a cross that we will not be able to carry. If the cross becomes too heavy for us to carry, our Lord Jesus Christ will come, together with His angels to lighten up our burdens. Like a shepherd, the Lord will carry the cross and us, His disciples, on His shoulders to bring us all to a green pasture.

Without the cross and without a sacrifice, it will be a false discipleship. If we want to follow Jesus, we will need to follow Him, not only in the places of miracles and healings, but also in place of sacrifice in Calvary.

Let us thank our Lord and Master Jesus Christ for calling us His disciples to follow Him. Let us thank the disciples of Our Lady Most Holy Rosary who made sacrifices from the day our church was established in 1948. I would like thank also our disciples today, you my dear parishioners, for carrying the cross of discipleship.
